# A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE WAIVER AND CONSENT IN CONNECTION WITH LEASE AGREEMENT

**WHEREAS**, Covelli Properties, Inc. ("Covelli") and the Trumbull County Educational Service Center (the "ESC") entered into that certain Lease Agreement, dated January 31, 2006, as amended (the "Lease"), pursuant to which the ESC leases the premises commonly known as 6000-6024 Youngstown-Warren Road, Niles, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Lease, Covelli is prohibited from letting certain commercial premises for the purpose of automobile repair work or automobile service; and

**WHEREAS,** Covelli has requested the ESC to execute the Waiver and Consent, substantially in the form attached hereto as "<u>Exhibit A.</u>" pursuant to which the ESC waives the above-referenced prohibition and consents to Covelli letting certain commercial premises for the operation of a Take Five Oil Change franchise; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the ESC to approve and authorize the execution of the Waiver and Consent;
