## LEARNING OPTIONS

### For those attending TCESC Specialized Units for Students with Disabilities

**Option 1: On-Site Learning 4 Days a Week**  
with one day of Remote Learning based on the school district in which the TCESC Unit is located.  
Individual days of assignment will come from the program supervisor, specific to your child.

**Option 2: Remote Learning 5 days a week**

*\* All students will have access to Chromebooks and remote learning technology as needed.*

## PROTOCOLS
